### AIMS TESTING & ATTENDANCE

#### Holsteiner Agricultural School Message to Parents

All Arizona public school students in grades 3 through 8 and 10 are required to take the AIMS test. The AIMS test includes four content areas: writing, reading, mathematics, and science. The reading and mathematics content areas are administered in all grades. The writing content area is administered in grades 5, 6, 7, and 10. The science content area is administered in grades 4, 8, and 10. 2nd grade takes Stanford 10 tests to prep them for 3rd grade.

We will begin practice testing the first week of April. Our formal testing

dates are scheduled for the week of April 16th. Testing is 1 hr each day.

This month especially - please have students well rested and to school on time. It is important that they feel prepared and ready this month. With only 46 more days of school (March 27-May 30) we need to have them here each & every day to meet their academic needs. If you plan on being late please call the front desk. Attendance records are sent home this month.
